ITEMS	ACCEPTED	NOT ACCEPTED
	<p>ONLY clean items are accepted. Place plates and trays loosely in the box. Aluminum foil sheets should be rolled into balls no smaller than 3" diameter and placed in the blue box.</p>	<p>DO NOT INCLUDE paper-backed foil (lids from take-out food) and foil laminates (potato chip bags).</p>
	<p>ONLY plastic bottles, tubs and lids with one of these symbols on the bottom:</p>  <p>Rinse bottles. Place loosely in the Blue Box. Remove lids and caps.</p>	<p>DO NOT INCLUDE bubble wrap, Styrofoam, lawn furniture, garden hose, plastic toys or any plastic item that does not have #1, #2, #3, #4, #5, #6 or #7 on the bottom.</p>
	<p>All glass bottles and jars are accepted, including colored glass. It is not necessary to remove labels. Remove and recycle metal lids - discard plastic lids. Rinse. Place loosely in the Blue Box.</p>	<p>DO NOT INCLUDE light bulbs, window glass, mirror glass, drinking glasses or ceramics (plates, mugs, etc...)</p>
	<p>All aluminum, tin and steel cans are accepted, including empty dry paint cans. Remove lids and caps.</p>	<p>DO NOT INCLUDE coat hangers, kitchen utensils, pots and pans.</p>
	<p>Place these items either inside a second Blue Box, in a bundle beside the Blue Box, or stacked under the Blue Box.</p> <p>Newspaper: Including all inserts that come inside them. Remove and discard plastic bags. Mixed Paper: Phone books, junk mail, magazines, catalogues (Sears/MacLean's), office paper & envelopes (window & regular), paper egg trays, paper bags, paper towel cores and other items that are 100% paper. Staples are accepted. Boxboard: Cereal, pasta, laundry and shoe boxes, etc. Remove liners and flatten boxes.</p>	<p>DO NOT INCLUDE waxed or foil-coated paper, potato chip bags, all cold and hot take-out cups (Tim Horton's/McDonald's) and Styrofoam.</p>
	<p>Break down and flatten boxes measuring no larger than 3'X3'. Place cardboard with other newspaper, mixed paper and boxboard but separated from glass, cans and plastic.</p>	<p>It is asked that you place all your cans, glass and plastic in one Blue Box, and all your newspapers, mixed papers, boxboard and corrugated cardboards in another.</p>
